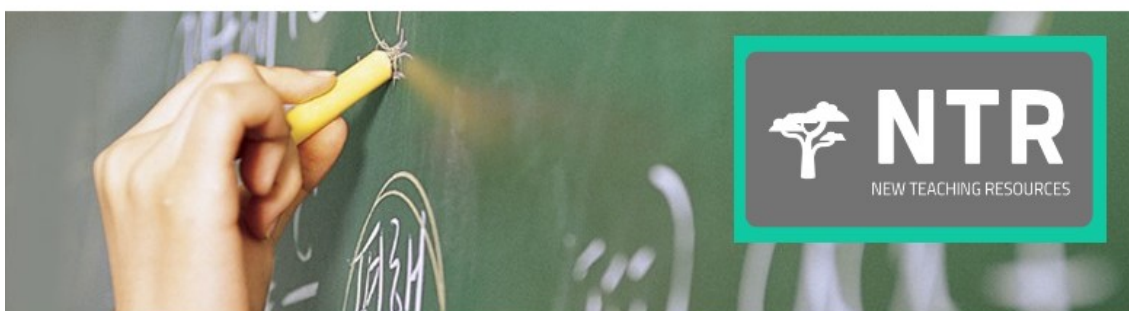

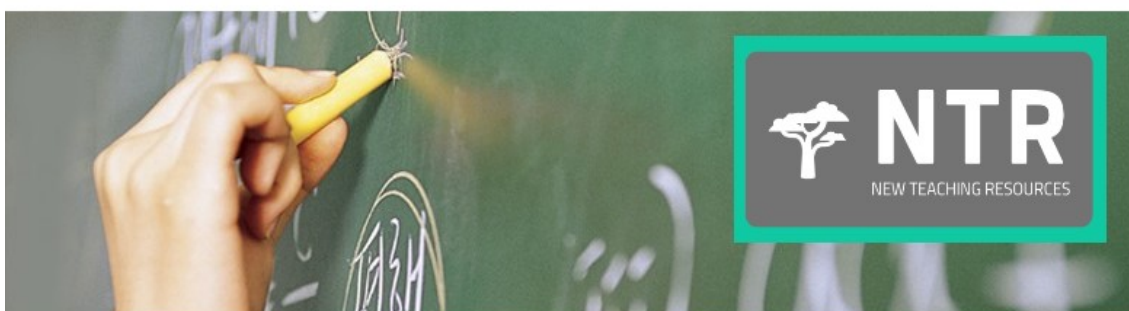
- Presentations
